S-Bahn

Free transportation on the S-Bahn in major German cities. In Berlin the Pass is only valid on the S-Bahn lines that connect the Berlin long-distance railway stations. S-Bahn can be recognized by the logo; White S on a green background.

Airport links

Berlin: the main airports are Berlin Tegel (TXL) and Berlin Schönefeld (SXF). From Tegel Airport there is a frequent bus service to Berlin Central Station (bus TXL - rail passes or rail tickets are not valid on the buses). From Schönefeld airport there are train connections to Berlin Hauptbahnhof (Central Station) and many other city and regional destinations (S-Bahn (every 20 minutes) and Regional-Express/Regionalbahn (every 30 minutes)).

Hamburg: from the airport there are connections to Hamburg Hbf by train (S-Bahn, every 10 minutes).

-Cologne - Köln/Bonn Apt: from the airport there are connections to Köln Hbf (Train: Regional-Express and S-Bahn, every 20 minutes) and Bonn Hbf (Bus: Express Service SB 60, every 30 to 60 minutes – Eurail passes not valid).

Hannover: from the main airport Hannover Langenhagen there are connections to Hannover Hbf by train (S-Bahn, every 30 minutes).

Dresden: from the airport there are connections to Dresden Hbf. Train (S-Bahn, every 30 minutes).

Düsseldorf: from the airport there are connections by train (S-Bahn, every 20 minutes) to Düsseldorf Hbf and to many other destinations.

Frankfurt: from Frankfurt Rhein/Main airport there are train connections to Frankfurt am Main Hbf and to many other destinations (regional trains and S-Bahn, every 10 to 15 minutes). The airport is also directly linked to the long-distance ICE/IC network.

Leipzig/Halle: from the airport there are connections to Leipzig Hbf, Halle(S) Hbf and to other destinations (regional trains, every 30 minutes).

Munich: from the main airport Munich F.J.Strauss there are connections to München Hbf and to many other regional destinations by train (S-Bahn, every 10 minutes).

Stuttgart: from the main airport Stuttgart Echterdingen there are connections to Stuttgart Hbf and to many other regional destinations by train (S-Bahn, every 10-20 minutes).
